Please also note that unfunded hours are currently £4.25 per hour but will be increasing to £4.50 after Christmas.

<u>ATTENDANCE INFORMATION</u> - We have been asked by several parents if it is possible to swap around their child's session days. Unfortunately, this causes issues with staffing ratios, so from now on we will be asking that you notify us four weeks before the end of each term, this term being by 21st November. Please let us know of any changes to your child's attendance for the following term. This will then give us plenty of time to arrange staffing accordingly and is hopefully an acceptable compromise - some flexibility for parents but also termly stability for staffing.

However, if you find that you need one off childcare at any point and we have capacity without changing staffing, we will be happy to accommodate that, just give us a call or speak to a member of staff before the day.

<u>SNACK DONATIONS</u> - This is another request for snacks please for the next half term - unlike a lot of settings we do not charge a snack fee, so definitely a cheaper option for all!
