STAFFING

DAY TIMINGS

Starting on Monday children will go straight into their classrooms when they arrive at school. Children must arrive at school at 8:40am and no earlier please. The children will go straight into their classrooms and start working. The register will close at 8:50am. If you arrive between 8:40 and 8:50am your child will be marked as present. If you arrive between 8:50 and 9:00am your child will be marked as 'Late'. If children arrives after 9:00am they will be marked as Unauthorised. If you arrive after 8:50am please come to the office and they will take your child to their classroom.

There will be a member of staff on the playground to welcome children and speak with parents if necessary.

COMMUNICATION

UNIFORM

Uniform with the school logo is available to purchase from Mole Avon Country Stores, Joseph Locke Way, Crediton EX17 3FD. School uniform without the school logo is also acceptable if it meets the below criteria.

- The school uniform is navy blue, grey or black.
- Children should not wear jewellery to school. Discrete stud earrings and watches are permitted, which should be removed for PE.
- Long hair should be tied back with a discrete hair fastening.

- Polo Shirt White
- Trousers, Pinafore, Skirt or Shorts Grey/Black
- Socks White or Grey/Black
- Shoes Black

<u>P.E.</u>

- T-shirt Yellow with Logo.
- Shorts Navy
- Plimsolls/Trainers Black
- Boots with studs may be useful when playing field sports

- Book Bags should be in school every day.
