Dear Parents/Carers

Ready for Anything is the opposite to a fire drill in which we need to keep the children safe inside the building. If there was toxic smoke from a nearby fire or a wild animal got onto the school grounds, we need to keep the children safe. We will be practising a Ready for Anything drill before Christmas.
